Tim is a former Marine Corps Sergeant and Purple Heart recipient from the Vietnam War. A violent land mine explosion in 1971 blinded him in a wheelchair, but also made him one of the most listened to people in America. He shares his personal testimony that has impacted the lives of U.S. Senators, Congressmen, Governors and local officials.
His remarks and conclusions on the topics he addresses are controversial and explosive, but they present strong Biblical truth and peacetime ideas in a way that captivates his audience.

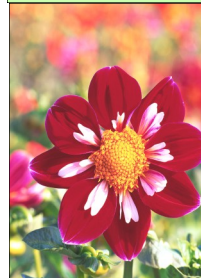
